

SUSTAINABILITY STATEMENT

With eyes firmly focused on the future the management and owners of Calkins & Burke are committed to preserving our world marine ecosystems based on principles of responsible fishing and long-term sustainability of resources.

Calkins & Burke uses the following criteria to define fish as sustainably sourced:

- Be a species that is not regarded as endangered (as defined by the **INTERNATIONAL UNION FOR THE CONSERVATION OF NATURE (IUCN) RED LIST**).

- Be caught from a well-managed fishery with scientifically based quota.
- Be fully traceable from catch to consumer (including FAO harvest area, method of catch, vessel name and date of fishing trip).
- Be caught by methods that avoid the incidental catch of all endangered fish species.
- Be caught by methods that do not utilize explosives or poisons.

Since fishing techniques and stock assessment are constantly changing, Calkins & Burke will annually update its diagnoses on the health of the fishery based on the latest facts and scientific reports.

Calkins & Burke is committed to the continual improvement of fish stocks

Calkins & Burke supports the concept of independent eco-certification and will source from and work toward the sustainable management and traceability of our products based on our customers' requirements for specific certifications.

These certifications are based on peer-reviewed scientific studies, regular audits, third-party certification, and the transparency of procedures and results. Among these are the following:
